An act to amend an act entitled
an act to incorporate the Lane Seminary
in the County of Hamilton

Section 1st Be it enacted by the
General Assembly of the State of Ohio

That the Board of Trustees of the Lane
Seminary shall consist of any number
not less than thirteen nor more than
twenty five & if from any cause the
number shall be reduced ~~below~~ below
thirteen the remaining number shall
be a competent board for the purpose of
filling vacancies to make up the
number of thirteen & from & after the
next election of Officers the Executive
Committee of said Seminary shall
consist only of the President the three
Vice Presidents the Treasurer the Recording
Secretary & the Corresponding Secretary
who shall hold their Offices until
their successors are elected; & the annual
meeting of the board of trustees for the
election of Officers shall be held on
the 2^d Wednesday of June annually
instead of the last Wednesday of
October
